
Based on this Policy, we:

1. Promote compliance with the law and internal procedures necessary for the correct development of -and to properly carry out- the company's activities and commercial operations involving interaction with public officials, by disseminating and raising awareness on this Policy.
2. Categorically reject and punish any illegal practice that, in addition to contravening the current laws, is contrary to the Code of Ethics and Conduct for Employees, and the Code of Ethics and Conduct for Suppliers and Contractors, as well as to the corporate values of Minsur.
3. Prepare, approve, disseminate and monitor compliance with our Corporate Procedure for Interaction with Public Officials, in order to contribute to the enforcement of this Policy, as well as to improve transparency and document interactions that both employees and strategic partners may have with public officials.

The Policy hereof, as well as the abovementioned procedure, allows managing the interests of the company, as well as the needs and expectations of our employees, customers, shareholders, business partners, non-governmental organizations, local communities, and society in general, in a timely and adequate manner.
